

San Miguel welcomes Italian diplomatic delegation

They will link commercial, gastronomic and cultural activities

San Miguel de Allende, Guanajuato. The Italian ambassador to Mexico, Luigi De Chiara, the Italian Honorary Consul in the Bajío region, Leonardo Franchini, and the head of the Italian economic and commercial office in Mexico, Dr. Flavio Sereni visited San Miguel de Allende were received at the palace municipal by authorities.

The Italian engineering and construction company '<u>Bonatti</u> México 'is installed in this municipality, so the ambassador pointed out: "here my compatriots are very well, they have expressed."

Likewise, the European country was invited to present in June representative cultural events such as literature, visual arts, dance, and music, as well as a gastronomic exhibition.

It will be in January when the head of mission of the Italian Embassy in Mexico returns to the municipality accompanied by the director of the Italian Cultural Institute to carry out the exchange.

Finally, Luigi De Chiara pointed out that "the embassy is willing to participate in the exchange of experiences to face the pandemic", due to COVID 19

As of last April, the head of the Tourist Council, Laura Torres Septién announced, the promotion strategy continues through the consuls of different cities and nations to seek profitable alliances for San Miguel and visiting destinations.
