



Bonatti lands Pertamina Algeria EPC work

Indonesia's national oil and gas company Pertamina has contracted Italian group Bonatti for upgrade work on the facilities serving its Menzel Lejmat Nord (MLN) field in Algeria.

Under the €85 million (\$100 million) contract, Bonatti will provide engineering, procurement and construction services to increase the capacity of the MLN facilities to treat the future expected gas flow and enhance production.

Bonatti's scope of work will also include the installation, pre-commissioning, commissioning and assistance to start-up of the Gas Capacity Increase Project (GCIP) at the MLN field as part of the fourth phase of the project's development.

"The aim of the GCIP is the development and upgrading of the existing facility for future expected gas treatment and oil production at 2020 by installation of two new 37.5-million-cubic-feet-per-day-compressors, a dehydration train and their related systems," Pertamina said in a statement.

The MLN field is located in the north of Block 405a, in the Algerian desert.
